Visakha Government Degree College for Women is the precious gift of Sri. Singavarapu Surya Rao garu freedom fighter and philanthropist, with whose initiation the college was established in 1975 and flourished into the present state of educating more than a thousand girl students from across all the sections of the society not just from in and around Visakhapatnam but also from all the neighboring districts.

## **Facilities Available**

Today, our institution has state of the art ICT enabled classrooms comprising of 03 Virtual classrooms, 03 Digital Classrooms with touch screen Smart TVs. 13 fully equipped laboratories including a Language Lab and Jawahar Knowledge Centre. An automated Library with KOHA software and a fully functional gymnasium, Two Seminar Halls, are available in the college to create a conducive environment in the college.

## **Courses Offered**

This is the only women's Government College in the Visakhapatnam District and offers 11 undergraduate courses and 4 Postgraduate Courses. In B.Sc. we offer B.Z.C.(EM), M.P.C.(EM), M.P.Cs.(EM), M.B.C. & B.B.C, in B.A. H.E.P(EM), H.E.P(TM), P.E.P(TM), Sw.E.P (TM) & Sw.Ed.P (TM) and in B.Com General. The Post Graduation Courses offered in the college are M.A. in Social Work, M.A. in English, M.Sc. in Psychology and M.Sc. in Microbiology.

## Curricular Enrichment

We are happy to announce that three new courses B.Sc. BZC (EM), MPC (EM) and B.A. HEP (EM) have been introduced into the graduation programme and four new PG courses M.A. Telugu, M.A. Economics, M.Sc. Mathematics and M.Com have been sanctioned. To be in tune with emerging needs of the society, a proposal for 8 new market-oriented courses have been submitted. Two diploma courses in Dance and Music have been introduced for the students to flourish their cultural aptitude. To enhance the employability skills of the students, we have introduced a Sewing Machine Operator (SMO) course in collaboration with APSSDC. Many certificate courses like Mobile App development, First Aid Training, Fundamentals of Statistics etc., have been introduced with a motto that each & every student must possess at least one additional skill along with her degree.
