I proudly convey that I have talented, industrious and dynamic team of faculty. We have Best Teacher Awardees. Even our students got Pratibha Awards. K. Pravallika of Ed. Sw. Psy. is the winner of Pratibha Award for the year 2018. Indumati from 2nd B.Sc. won 25000/- cash prize in Jnanabheri elocution competition.

Health Club organized in association with Kala Hospital for staff, students and general public. Dental camp was conducted in association with Apple Dental Hospital.

In this globalized and digitalized world our students are reaping the fruits of technology based education. In our college we have 3 virtual classrooms worth 9,61,000 /- and 3 digitalclassrooms worth 4,35,000/- Our faculty have been imparting education through these E- Learning tools and technology. Our faculty were also trained in developing E-Content.

Our students are also beingexposed to co-curricular activities. The dept. of Hindi had taken the students to Kurnool for a field trip where the students were exposed to different geographical and cultural identities. The depts. of commerce, English and Telugu went to an educational tour. Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science and Mathematics depts. have taken the students to GITAM University. The

depts. of Economics, History, Political Science, Botany, Microbiology and Biotech organized a trip of historical site seeing in and around Vizag.

It's my privilege to announce that ours is one of the colleges funded by RUSA which had sanctioned 2 crores of which 70 lakhs were spent on the construction of a spacious seminar hall and a library. Beautification of the college was done with 70 lakhs and purchased 60 lakhs worth equipment. I am happy to inform you that we are taking part in the environment friendly initiatives as we are utilizing solar energy. Our college has 16 solar panels worth 16.85 lakhs.

I am honoured to convey that our college was recently sanctioned an NCC wing in 2017. Dr.Sudha is the NCC in charge. The 56 NCC cadets have been actively participating in all the social service activities including beach cleaning, cleaning the statues of great personalities and national leaders and participating in Swaccha Bharat rallies. We at VGDC (w) are not only catering to the needs of the local areas as a part of the Social Responsibility but also working hard to fulfil the dreams of the students through JKC. The Jawahar Knowledge Centre- JKC unit has been relentlessly trying to improve the life skills and communication skills of the students so as to enable them in becoming successful citizens in the society and also shaping them as employable candidates for the job sector. Our students are proving their ability in the Job Drives and becoming economically independent. This academic year we have conducted 2 Mega Job Drives in the months September and February and a total no. of 110 students were selected/ short listed or got offer letters. The JKC has conducted a special training programme in collaboration with JCI vizag, for 5 days from 5/2/19 to 11/2/19 on interview skills, grooming, presentation skills etc.
