One of the key changes is the consolidation of three major systems into a single major system. For the Academic year 2023-24, this institution offered 14 single major UG Programmes and 12 PG Programmes. The UG programmes includes 7 science programmes, 3 arts, 1 commerce and 3 BBA programmes with an enrollment rate of 85%.
