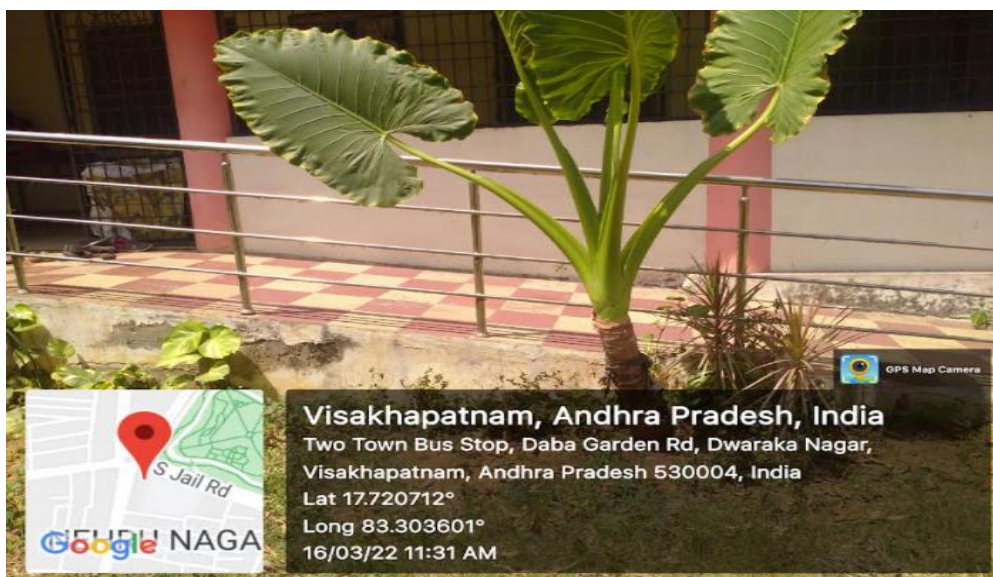
JAWS software is an assistive technology that facilitates the visually impaired students to use computers.

The college central library facilitates the visually impaired students with the reading skills and knowledge enrichment by providing access to audio books downloaded on a monthly basis from Amazon. In addition to the audio books there is a special provision for students to learn English pronunciation dictionary to improve their speaking abilities.

On the request of physically challenged students Scribes are appointed to help write their exams.

Environment with ramps

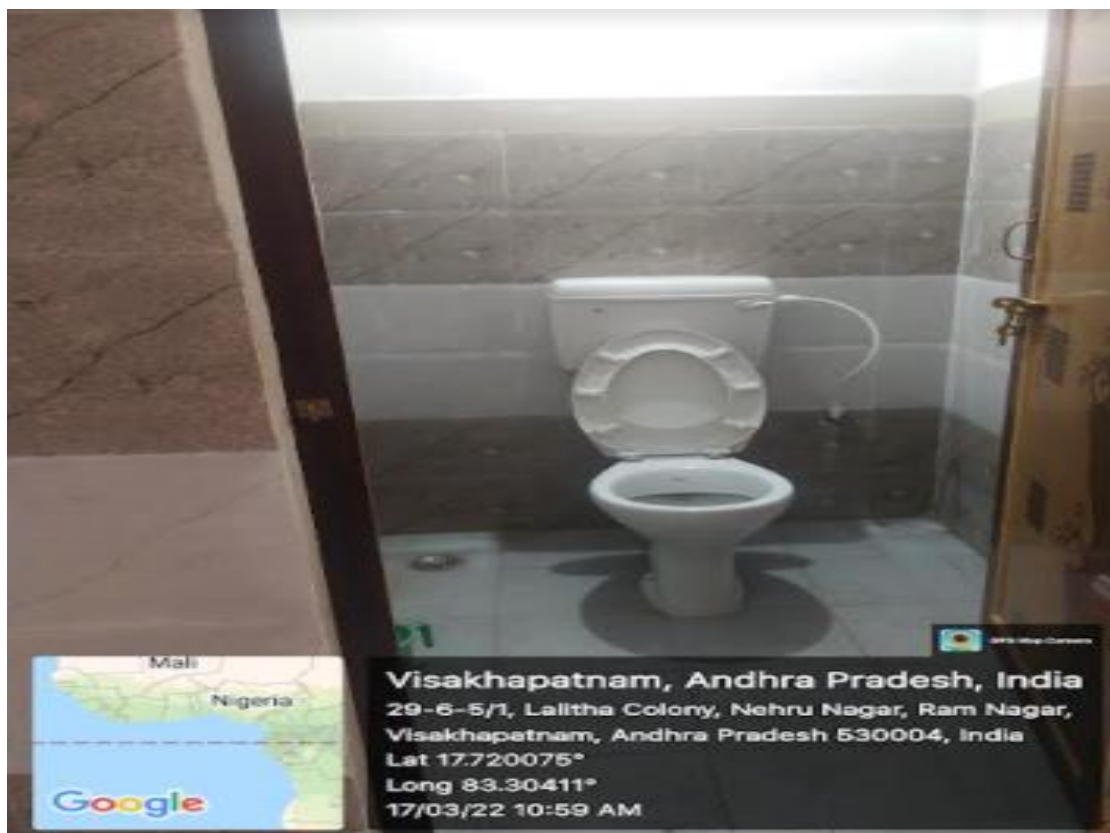





Lift facility


