
1. Whereas the main objective of the CSU is to promote, develop, propagate disseminate and preserve Sanskrit in all its aspects through any accepted mode, including Sanskrit learning under its Non Formal Sanskrit Education (NFSE) activity.
2. And whereas for implementing its NFSE activity, the CSU makes collaborations with the Universities, Colleges, Institutions etc. desirous of promoting Sanskrit learning to its students/staff and general public within its reach, through NFSE Centre along with other similar academic activities at their organisation.

3. And whereas, pursuant to the proposal submitted by **Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women**, for running of NFSE Centre, the CSU intends to collaborate with it for opening of the NFSE Centre in its premises and sign the MOU therefore.
4. And whereas, the CSU will provide the following facilities, arrangements and material for conducting the prescribed courses in this NFSE Centre-
- Trained Sanskrit Teacher.
  - Prescribed monthly remuneration to be paid by CSU. (In addition to his duties in the allotted Centre, he may be required to teach the learners at any other nearby Centre/Centres if required).
  - Reading material for the learners
  - Prescribed guidelines for NFSE
  - Conducting examination at the end of academic session and awarding certificate/diploma to the successful candidates.
5. And whereas, the CSU will undertake Sanskrit education for Certificate Course in Sanskrit Language and Diploma in Sanskrit language of the duration of one year each for the learners in NFSE Centre. Learners enrolled in the Centre will be required to deposit prescribed Registration fee to the CSU.
6. And whereas **Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women** will provide the facilities and extend support as under-
- Suitable arrangements for functioning of NFSE Centre, including seating arrangements, infrastructure, electricity etc.
  - Nominating a faculty member as authorised officer to coordinate functioning of the Centre. He will be required to ensure that the courses are conducted as per the provisions prescribed in the guidelines for NFSE.
  - Publicising the Sanskrit learning courses of CSU in non formal mode and also making arrangement of the same at its Centre.
7. And whereas in any matter concerning the NFSE Centre or any issue arising in conducting the courses, the same will be resolved jointly by the authorised officers of CSU and **Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women**.
8. This MOU will be valid initially for one academic session and may be extended mutually. Now, therefore, in witness whereof, this MOU is executed and signed by the officers of CSU and **Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women**

- i. is required to be disclosed by law, by order of a court of competent jurisdiction or by any law, rule or regulatory or governmental body having jurisdiction (provided that any Party so required shall if legally permissible and reasonably practicable inform the other Party about disclosure); or where the Confidential Information is in or comes in to the public domain or is generally available to the public, in each case, other than as a result of breach of this MoU.

Any notice or other communication sent by post shall be sent by prepaid registered post and any notice sent by fax must be followed up by delivery through courier.

## 8. NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF MOU

- a) Either Party by giving one month's notice in writing to the Other Party may terminate this MOU before its expiry.
- b) Both Parties shall also have the right to terminate the MOU without prior notice if
  - a) there occurs a breach of any terms of this MOU which remains uncured for a period of fifteen (15) days after being notified in writing to the other Party;
  - b) Either Party commits any act or omission which harms the reputation of the other party
  - c) Either party acts in a manner prejudicial to the interest of the other and affected party shall be the sole judge in this regards.

AND WHEREAS, HSSC through its Education & Skill Development Initiatives will work closely with its training and Industry Partners to develop the industry specific program (NSQF or Non NSQF) and related learning resources with an aim to facilitate hands-on experience and learning to make students skilled ready workforce. The programs shall focus on developing an ecosystem which will be highly rewarding and promising for the aspirants making them the best fit for the Industry.

Now it is hereby mutually agreed amongst both parties to this MOU and binds themselves to the terms and conditions enumerated in succeeding paragraphs/Annexures:

**1. Roles and Responsibility**

The principal roles and responsibility of the parties will be as set out in Annexure A.

**2. Parties Shall**

- A. Not use other party's Intellectual Property unless such other party consents to use.
- B. Not do anything which in the reasonable opinion of the other party is or will be harmful to the reputation of the other party.
- C. Keep each other informed of any matters relevant to the overall functioning.
- D. Share their expertise or any other information which would be of mutual benefit.
- E. Share required details of students undertaking the programs.

**3. Financial Terms and Conditions**

The financial terms and conditions will be as set out in Annexure B.

**4. Duration/ Term of the MOU:**

- A. The MOU shall begin from the date of its execution by the parties hereto.
- B. This MOU shall continue in full force and effect up to 5 years from the date of signing i.e. upto \_\_\_\_\_, 2026, that is the term required for completion of the agreed programme as mentioned in Annexure C.
- C. Validity of this MOU shall be extended sufficiently early for further period/batches on mutual agreement by the parties to the MOU.
- D. This Memorandum of Understanding is a document of good faith and Implementation of the MOU would be monitored on a six-monthly basis.

**5. Termination**

- a) Either party may terminate this MOU by mutual understanding by giving 3 (three) months' notice in writing served on other.
- b) The parties to the MOU understand that, where a course, as aforesaid, is under continuance, the termination shall take effect only on completion of the subsisting course.



## 7. Confidentiality

- Has in it's entirely become public knowledge otherwise than through any unauthorised disclosure or other breach of such restriction.
  - The other party has consented in writing to the same being disclosed.
  - Is or has been independently developed by the other party without reference to or use of the confidential information.

## 8. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes and differences whatsoever arising under or in connection with this MOU which could not be settled by parties through negotiations, after the period of thirty (30) working days from the service of the notice, shall be finally settled by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The parties will make reference for a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the parties in consultation with each other. The place of arbitration shall be at New Delhi.







2. And whereas for implementing its NFSE activity, the CSU makes collaborations with the Universities, Colleges, Institutions etc. desirous of promoting Sanskrit learning to its students/staff and general public within its reach, through NFSE Centre along with other similar academic activities at their organisation.

    - a. Suitable arrangements for functioning of NFSE Centre, including seating arrangements, infrastructure, electricity etc.
    - b. Nominating a faculty member as authorised officer to coordinate functioning of the Centre. He will be required to ensure that the courses are conducted as per the provisions prescribed in the guidelines for NFSE.
    - c. Publicising the Sanskrit learning courses of CSU in non formal mode and also making arrangement of the same at its Centre.



This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as the "MOU") is executed in Andhra Pradesh on 01-07-2023 and is effective from 01-07-2023 ("Effective Date") and valid till 30-06-2024 entered into by and between:

Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women, Visakhapatnam having its office at D.NO. 29-10-1/3, Suryabagh, Old Jail Road, Dabagardens and represented by the Dr S Shobha Rani, Principal .

And

Nirmaan Organization, H.No. 1-98/9/3, flat no 401, Plot no. 3, Jaihind enclave, Madhapur, Hyderabad - 500081. Here in after also collectively and individually referred to as "Parties" and "Party", respectively and represented by Shri. Mayur Patnala, Founder & CEO, Nirmaan Organization.





**WHEREAS,** Visakhā Government Degree College is an exclusive college for women located in the heart of the city established in 1975. The institution is offering 31 undergraduate and post graduate programmes including conventional and market-oriented courses catering to the needs of around 2000 students.

And

**WHEREAS,** Nirmaan has represented that it is a Not-for-Profit charitable society that has since its inception carried various welfare activities for the under privileged and the objectives of the Society are to promote Livelihood, education and health initiatives/projects either directly or through its partners in India and hence is eligible under the Societies Act to receive CSR contributions from companies; and (hereinafter referred to as “**Nirmaan Organization**”) which expression shall be deemed to mean and include its successors and permitted assigns, of the Other Part.

## **1. Introduction**

- 1.1 This MOU lays out the intention of Visakhā Govt. Degree College for Women and Nirmaan Organization to enter into a mutually beneficial partnership for providing employability to needy and unaddressed communities in Andhra Pradesh.
- 1.2 The purpose of this MOU is that Nirmaan Organization will provide employment in local available organizations to the women, youth, PWD, and LGBTQ communities across Andhra Pradesh
- 1.3 This memorandum is being entered into, to have a common and high-level understanding of conducting activities to achieve the goal mentioned above. If required, both parties will define roles and responsibilities tailor-made to a specific situation.

## **2. Objective of this Relationship**

- 2.1 Visakhā Govt. Degree College for Women and Nirmaan organization identify the Unemployed youth from low-income households who are under Below Poverty Line (BPL) income below 5 lakhs per annum and provide them employment in locally available organizations at minimum income standards.



### **3- General Provisions:**

- 3.1 This Memorandum will set up general conditions for cooperation in Skill Based Training under NIRMAAN and that the Parties intend to use it as a framework to continue their cooperation.
- 3.2 The parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation to provide employment.

### **4- MONITORING**

- 4.1 Implementation of the Project will be jointly monitored by Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women and NIRMAAN
- 4.2 The parties will meet regularly to monitor the implementation of the MoU as per the timelines agreed and Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women will share the data regularly.

### **5 - The understandings of the agreements are as follows:-**

#### **5.1 - Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women will support in the following ways:**

- 5.1.0 Will provide the venue within the college for conduct of Job drives
- 5.1.1 Will support Awareness campaign/ print message in leading newspaper from department to create awareness about the opportunities.
- 5.1.2 Will help in Mobilization of beneficiaries.
- 5.1.3 Explore internship/ placement opportunities across government departments
- 5.1.4 Support in Volunteering engagement
- 5.1.5 Will Allowing Employers for Guest lecturer, OJT, Campus drives, Career Mela, Job fairs.

#### **NIRMAAN will execute the following activities:**

- 6.1. Detailed need assessment
- 6.2. Mobilization – counseling whenever required.
- 6.3. Motivational sessions, placement support - impact assessment

- 6.4. Nirmaan organization identifies the Unemployed youth with the support of the Visakha Govt. Degree College for Women or on their own mobilization from low-income households those are under Below Poverty Line (BPL).
- 6.5. Will mobilize the candidates across Andhra Pradesh and allow the unemployed youth candidates in the Complete Andhra Pradesh region.
- 6.6. Skill gap studies and assessment of need by the state department to improve employability.

## **7- Target Beneficiaries:**

### **7.1 Nirmaan selects the youth with the below criteria**

UNEMPLOYED Youth and Girls & women who are orphans, semi-orphans, below the poverty line (BPL)

- 7.1.1. Persons with disabilities (Gender Neutral)
- 7.1.2. LGBTQ+ communities
- 7.1.3. Age group of 18 -27
- 7.1.4. Who are domicile of Andhra Pradesh state
- 7.1.5. Who have passed 12th class/polytechnic/Bachelor in the streams of computer science, electronics, and communications, computer applications majorly/any other relevant streams
- 7.1.6. Ready and able to work

## **9. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**




- 9.1 The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) as outlined in this document is not intended to be a legally binding document. Rather, it is meant to describe the nature and cooperative intentions of Andhra Pradesh and NIRMAAN to suggest guidelines for cooperation. Nothing, therefore, shall diminish the full autonomy of either party, nor any constraints be imposed by either upon the other, and nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to create a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the parties.
- 9.2 Any other matter not included in this MoU which is necessary for the smooth functioning of the Scheme shall be finalized among Andhra Pradesh and NIRMAAN on mutual terms and conditions.



9.3 The Memorandum of Understanding is not intended to create any legal relation of employer-employee or of principal and agent relationship amongst the parties.

10 This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain valid for till 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024 from the date of its signing and can be extended on mutual terms and conditions.
